



- The Pantry served **10,660** individuals **623,818** meals in 2019. This is an increase of 17% over 2018.
- CORA distributed **1,037,456** pounds of food in 2019 through the Pantry, SNACK!, Backpack and federal programs.
- **485,798** pounds of food were donated to CORA in 2019.
- CORA distributed **935,661** meals in 2019 through the Pantry, SNACK!, Backpack and federal programs.
- **156,970** SNACK! meals were distributed in 2019.
- **1,463** children participated in the SNACK! Program in 2019. This is an increase of 26% over 2018.
- **12** schools received support for their Backpack Programs.
- **300** people volunteered throughout 2019, providing **9,833** volunteer hours.
- **49%** of our clients are the most vulnerable in our community. They are between the ages of birth to 17 and 65+.

Our Mission:

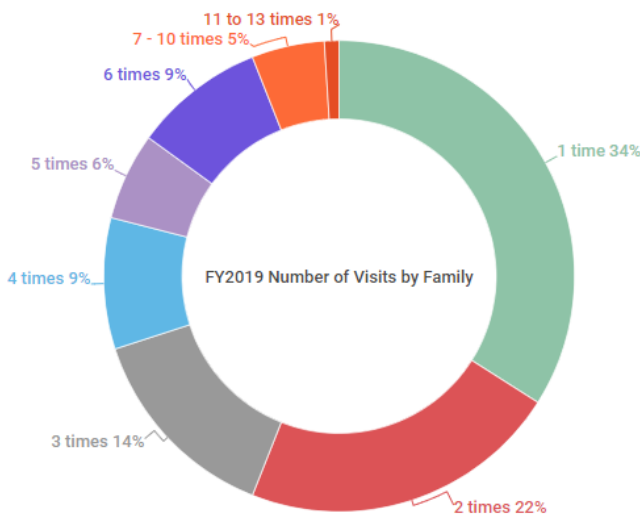
We provide food to individuals and families within our community who are in need during difficult personal economic periods.

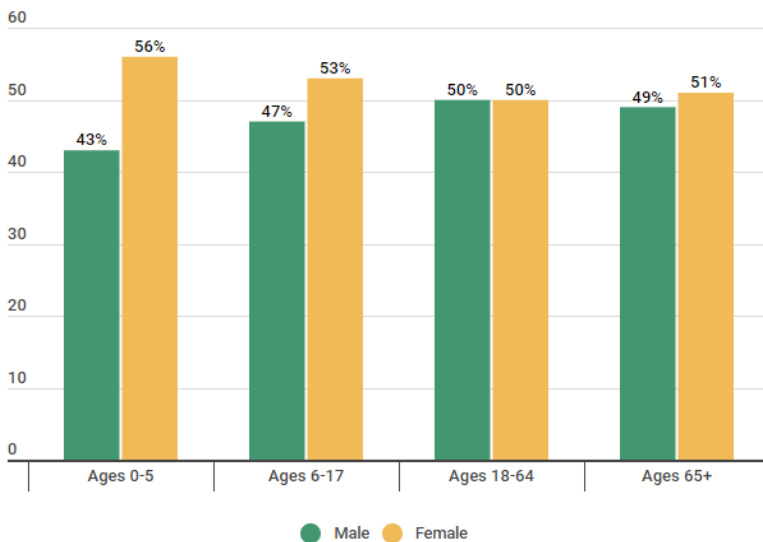

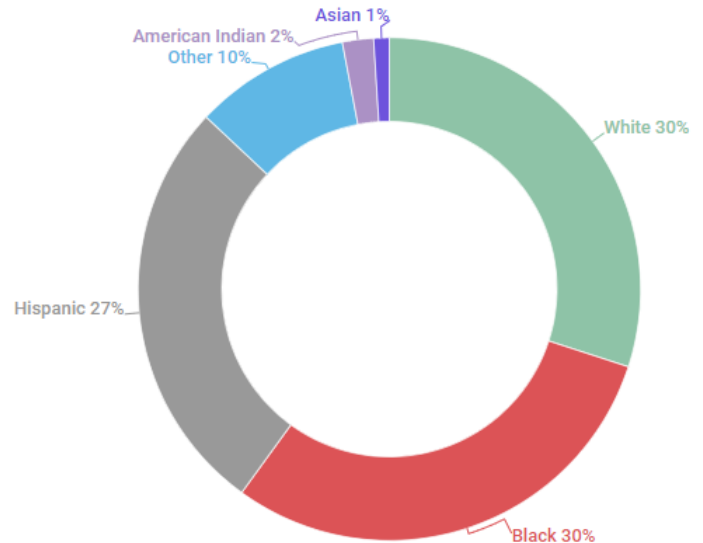
Family Visits
